In 2016, our school launched a **\$10.5 million Transformed Capital Campaign** to purchase and to develop our campus property. God has blessed us with more than \$8.5 million in gifts to date. Amazingly, we have already completed our 2020 goal of raising \$1 million.

However, in March 2020, we came to a great COVID-19 valley. As a result, we face **\$500,000 in unexpected additional expenses** for the year ahead. This great challenge includes providing tuition assistance for parents who lost their jobs during COVID-19, technology and staffing expenses for the new CHS Online School for students who cannot return to campus, and implementing the 120 "Safe Smart Schools" protocols.

GOD'S BLESSINGS CONTINUE TO FALL DURING THE COVID-19 CRISIS


- Record new student enrollment and many new families welcomed to campus this fall.

CASTLE HILLS COMES UPON A "COVID CANYON" IN THE MIDST OF ITS BEST YEAR ON RECORD


We could not have imagined, in this greatest year on record, that we would have come to such a great challenge! Three results of the COVID-19 crisis are:

1. Parents of 65 students lose jobs or are laid off – losing hope to continue in Christian education.
2. Our need to reinvent how we safely do school on campus to protect students and teachers.
3. The expense required to develop a CHS Online School for children who could not return to campus for health or other COVID-19-related reasons.



WHEN CHS FAMILIES STARTED LOSING JOBS through layoffs and furloughs, Mr. Pinkston made a statement: **"Families go through hard times together, and this school family will go through this hard time together."** To date, we are working to assist almost 65 students who should not have been able to continue in Christian school during the pandemic. Your support of the Eagle Banquet Fund will keep those students at Castle Hills until we get past this pandemic.



TEX CAREY has served on the Board of Trustees since 2009. He served as Chairman of the Board from 2011 to 2020 and currently serves as President Emeritus. Tex retired as a Colonel after serving in the U.S. Air Force for 29 years. In 1966 during the Vietnam War, he completed 100 missions over North Vietnam. Tex also held various command and management positions during his five-year assignment at the Pentagon. Tex earned a bachelor's degree from Baylor University and a master's degree in Public Administration from Auburn University. Tex served as president of his HOA for seven years and currently serves at Parkhills Baptist Church, where he and his wife, Joan, are members. Tex and Joan have two sons, two grandchildren, and two great-grandchildren.

FEATURED GUEST

ALVEDA KING is the niece of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. and the daughter of Reverend A. D. King and Naomi Barber King. Alveda is a minister of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and serves as Director of African American Outreach for Gospel of Life. Alveda is a former college professor and holds a master's degree in Business Management. Her undergraduate studies in journalism and sociology helped her to become a published author, with her best-selling books being *Sons Of Thunder: The King Family Legacy* and *I Don't Want Your Man, I Want My Own*.

During the years of the Civil Rights Movement, led by her Uncle, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Alveda's family home was bombed in Birmingham, Alabama, in the heat of the struggle. *"Daddy's house was bombed, then in Louisville, Kentucky his church office was bombed. I was also jailed during the open housing movement,"* she recalls. Alveda has continued her long-term work as a civil rights activist, speaking out on issues that face society today. Perhaps the most compelling issue of all is the life of the unborn, Alveda says. *"Faith in God, and the commitment to fulfill His will for our lives - not faith in government bureaucracy - is the key to positive action. Have faith in God!"* This is the message that Alveda carries to the world.
